



# **TEAM INSTRUCTIONS**

### Teams are encouraged to:

### **1**. Find three enthusiastic spellers to represent your team.

**Fill out the Team Registration form** and submit your registration fee. Line up alternates. Must have 3 members to compete in the BEE!!!! Team members will be asked to help sell tickets for the Grate Groan Up Spelling Bee Raffle. (minimum one book per team member – this is not a requirement)

# 2. Raise pledges!!! Set your goal! Win the Gratest Pledges Raised Trophy.

- Ask friends, co-workers, and family members to sponsor you. Tax receipts will be issued for donations of \$20 or more.
- Use your Fundraising page for online donations to promote and share your team with your contacts and the community.
- Use hard copy pledge sheet to ask for donations from people that don't do online giving. These pledges can be added to your online page.
- > Win the "Bees Knees" prizes for raising the "Gratest Pledges" (TBA.)
- A \$500.00 donation will buy a word that will be announced at the Bee as being sponsored by the individual or business that made the donation. Literacy for Life will choose the word.
